

American Legion Baseball Raffle Information/Guidelines

- The Alliance will provide the 4 Alaska Airlines tickets for the raffle. There will be no charge to the teams that participate in the raffle for the prize.
- The Dimond Alumni will administrate the raffle using their permit. Dimond Alumni receives 5% of the gross sales for the use and administration of the raffle.
- The cost to print the raffle tickets will be divided evenly between the teams that participate in the raffle.
- Tickets will sell for \$10.00. Teams net proceeds will be \$9.30 - \$9.48 per ticket (depending on the cost of the raffle tickets).
- All monies collected will be deposited in the Dimond Alumni Gaming Account (State requirement). Deposit slips will be mailed out to the Dimond Alumni Gaming Account. Each team will be making their own deposits and notify Don Winchester via email (donwinchester@yahoo.com) of the amount and date of the deposit.
- All stubs of tickets sold must be turned in (for drawing)
- All unsold tickets must be turned in
- Lost tickets are seller's responsibility.
- Drawing will be the Bp Invitational Champ. Game June 30

Money raised will go toward the following in this order:

All team and player fees have a due date. If not enough money has been raised by that date...the amounts are still owed by teams and due by cash, check or bankcard. They however can be reimbursed.

1. Team Fee CIC teams and Legion AA and A Teams.
2. Individual players fees for CIC teams and player fee for Legion teams 2019.

3. Legion team travel via airlines in - state, i.e. travel to and from Southeast Alaska and Kodiak. Additional HS travel within the State of Alaska may be reimbursed, but must be turned in no later than May 15, 2019 to be reimbursed.

4. Legion team ground or other in-state travel up to \$3,000 per team based on submitted receipts. This should apply to bus travel, ground and water transportation, hotels, dorms and other travel items with receipts. This is done after expenses directly paid by Legion teams with receipts provided to the Alliance for documentation of costs. The limit is \$3,000 per AA and \$3,000 per A team.

5. Field prep expenses by teams on their home field up to \$35 per game if dirt infield, and \$20 if FieldTurf. Up to \$750 per each AA team AA and \$750 for A team. Must be turned in by August 15, 2019

Ground Rules:

1. Teams must opt in and Post Managers/designee is responsible for all raffle tickets and money turned in.

2. Tickets will be issued in early January. Teams can choose how many raffle tickets they want to sell.

If team enters the raffle, the first monies will go toward that insurance fee for each team that has insurance.

3. All CIC team and player monies must be turned in no later than April 23, 2019 to qualify for reimbursement

4. All Legion Team fees monies must be turned in no later than May 23, 2019 to qualify for reimbursement.

5. All Legion player fees monies must be turned in no later than June 8, 2019 to qualify for reimbursement.

Drawing will take place on June 30, 2019 at the BP Invitational.

Legion team travel is to be paid by individual teams on their own and then they will be reimbursed depending on amount of raffle monies turned in toward Legion air travel in the State of Alaska.

All request for reimbursement for legion team travel in the State of Alaska must be turned in later than August 15, 2019. Any requests received after that day will not be accepted.
